JOB DESCRIPTION: UBC Campus Ministry Director

The campus ministry director will develop and lead an existing ministry at the University of British Columbia. They will recruit and manage a multi-staff team and a leadership team of student volunteers; provide pastoral care and support to student leaders and staff; encourage growth and maturity in discipleship to Jesus; initiate and supervise effective outreach and service to the campus; cultivate relationships with the larger UBC Christian community; develop community building events; and develop new initiatives as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Discipleship

- Individual discipleship of students and student leaders
- Leadership development for staff team and student leadership team
- Preaching at fellowship gatherings
- Pastoral care for staff team and student leadership team
- Oversee development of small group Bible study curriculum

Outreach

- Facilitate team initiatives: speakers, community events, mission trips
- Prepare curriculum for semester-long studies and training

Administration

- Communication with ministry members and the public: emails, phone calls, social media
- Coordinate regular and occasional events
- Keep track of financial contributions, expense reports, and working hours
- Build and maintain a local advisory board
- Liaise with local churches, UCM alumni, and UBC community

Personal and Staff Development

- Lead local staff meetings, actively participate in district Lead Team meetings, staff prayer, and staff retreats
- Pastoral care and accountability for staff team
- Academic development towards becoming a credential-holder of the PAOC and further professional development thereafter
- Seeking and utilizing personal spiritual mentorship (ideally within UCM)
- Continuing to pursue personal relationship with Christ

Connection with UBC Community

- Participate in monthly meetings with the Association of Christian Clubs at UBC
- Cultivate connections and relationships with the larger UBC Christian community
- Participate in bi-monthly meetings with the Multifaith Chaplains Association as a Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada Chaplain

Fundraising

- Build a team of donors through individuals and churches (training and coaching provided)
- Be available to spiritually minister to support team
- Raise adequate funds to provide personal support and ministry needs (\$75000 approx)
- Write newsletters to supports to cast vision, share updates, and make prayer requests

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ideal candidate would have:

- An authentic, vibrant, and growing faith in Christ
- Bachelor's degree (secular or theological)
- Ministry experience (campus ministry experience would be a particular asset)
- Passion for discipleship and campus ministry
- PAOC or transferable credentialed (willingness to pursue credentialing considered)

COMPENSATION:

Hours: Full-time (37.5 hours per week)

Salary: As a campus missionary, your salary would be raised through personal fundraising. UCM provides fundraising training and has a track record of long-term success for its employees' funding. An approved budget (like a teacher's salary grid) will be determined annually.
