JOB DESCRIPTION: Associate Campus Minister (Men's ministry, Surrey-based)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Outreach Ministry

- Participate in public campus outreach and training for students (display table, surveys, mission trips, etc.)
- Coordinate Red Frogs ministry (<https://ca.redfrogs.com>)

Leadership Development

- Lead and train student leaders
- Prepare curriculum for semester-long studies and training

Pastoral Care

- Attend weekly staff meeting
- Provide pastoral care to male students in the ministry
- Oversee ministries on Surrey campus alongside a female campus minister
- Participate in weekly Tuesday Night gathering on Burnaby campus

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ideal candidate would have:

- Theological training
- Ministry experience
- University/college degree or familiarity with campus ministry

COMPENSATION:

Hours: Full-time (40 hours/week)
