KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for youth ages 12 to 17
- Lead and facilitate *Plot*, which is a weekly drop-in ministry. This involves planning activities, booking special services, recruiting and leading a volunteer team, advertising, as well as hands-on work with the teens
- Developing and leading two week-long camps (sports themed and/or art themed) in July
- Planning and leading 2 one-day activities for Junior Highs and Senior Highs
- Assist in planning and facilitating the Annual Canada Day Carnival
- Spiritually nurturing youth by modeling a Christ-directed life
- Assist in the execution of the Year End Youth Gala (if needed)

Additional Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Must submit to a current Police Security Check and a Vulnerable Sector Check
- Will work closely with the Youth Ministry staff/volunteers and the Children's Intern
- Will attend weekly staff meetings and other meetings as required

QUALIFICATIONS

- A heart for God displayed in everyday life
- Leadership skills and a genuine heart for reaching children and youth within our community
- Basic sports knowledge
- Ability or willingness to recruiting volunteers from a wide pool
- Experience with and a love for children and youth
- Joy and enthusiasm in serving
- Current education in social services, education, or religious studies.
- Must have a driver's license and access to a vehicle
- Must be willing to make Bethel their home church during the term of employment
- Must have most weekdays and some evenings/weekends available during their placement
- Experience in promotions is an asset

- 35 hours per week for 14 consecutive weeks
- This position starts May 24, 2022 and ends in August 26, 2022
