- Act as the point person and a partner for communication with parents. Train and encourage adult leaders to lead Sunday morning and serve in all areas of Children's ministry.

- Participation in our kid's sports leagues, some administration and connecting with kids and parents.

- Ability to work and collaborate with staff and volunteer teams.
