We are looking for someone with a vision and passion for pastoral ministry to teens, their families, and growing integrated disciples into the life of the church.

This position is being posted as part-time. The schedule is flexible and will allow for bi-vocational ministry. There is opportunity for a candidate, with the right calling, and skillset to include other ministries in the portfolio and increase the hours (some categories we would consider are: young adult ministry, continuing a rebuild of the church small group ministry, missions & outreach, communications/tech oversight).

Anticipated start date is late August/early September.

This will be a one-year contract, which is standard for all our new hires (*probationary period*). At the end of the probationary period, if both parties agree, the position will become a permanent role.

Salary will be negotiable based on candidate, education, and experience.

Present Youth Ministry Portfolio Includes:

- Running and oversight of a weekly youth night (currently Friday night that has 30+ teens in attendance).
- Oversight of a discipleship framework for teens being taught by adult leaders which has included
 - a Sunday morning youth discipleship (20+ teens in attendance, many of whom are different from the Friday night group)
 - a current midweek discipleship evening (15+ teens in attendance, many of whom crave deeper discussion than allows on Friday nights, or Sunday mornings)
- Leading a team of a dozen adult and young adult volunteers, encouraging and equipping them for the ministry.

Christian Fellowship Assembly is located in Grande Prairie, Alberta.

- Grande Prairie is a growing city of 70,000
 people, 450 km northwest of Edmonton. It is a
 young population with the average age of
 citizens being 35. The main industries are oil &
 gas, lumber, and farming. It is a service
 community for Northwestern Alberta and
 Northeastern BC, serving a population of
 200,000+ who shop and do business in the
 city and surrounding county.
- CFA is a part of the Fellowship of Christian
 Assemblies. The FCA is a non-denominational
 fellowship of churches with Pentecostal
 theology and believing in the autonomy of the
 local church. It formed out of the Assemblies of
 God and has celebrated 100 years this year.
- CFA is a mid-sized church. Before COVID, we had an attendance of 550+ through two services on Sundays. We saw a significant decline through 2020-2022. However, we are seeing new growth and our Sunday attendance is now averaging 380-400, and we are planning to go back to two services again this fall. We have an estimated congregation of 600+ people, but due to work schedules and attendance patterns many people only attend 1-2 services a month.

Present pastoral team include:

- Lead Pastor: Glenn Breitkreuz, who has pastored the congregation for 35 years.
- Executive Pastor: Kim Penney, who has been on staff for 20 years, coming from and education background and formerly serving as our Family and Children's Pastor.
- Community Life Pastor: Steve King, who has been on staff for 7 years and oversees church ministries, group ministries, connecting newcomers and new believers.
- Creative Arts Pastor: Amanda Sherwin, who has been on staff for 7 years and oversees worship ministry and the creative side of admin and weekly ministries.
- Family & Children's Pastor: Nancy Westad, who has been on staff for 5 years and oversees children's ministries.
